This one-day course is designed for civilian firearm owners seeking a safe, practical introduction to rifles.

The course blends easy-to-understand classroom instruction with supervised live-fire training on the range, allowing students to apply what they've learned in a controlled, supportive environment. Whether you are new to firearms or looking to reinforce safe handling practices, this course provides the knowledge and confidence needed for responsible handgun ownership.
